Meeting venue

Accommodation, meals and costs

A package deal has been arranged and it includes refreshments during coffee breaks, lunches, welcome reception (Monday evening, February 19, 2024), conference dinner (Tuesday evening, 20 February 2024) and a visit to Kaunas city centre (Tuesday evening, 20 February 2024).

The cost of this package is 100 Euros.

The Kaunas walking tour (Tuesday afternoon, 20 February 2024) will go through the old town.

Depending on interest, an **optional excursion** will be arranged (Thursday, 22 February 2024) to Trakai Castle – Vilnius old town tour (full day; max 8 hours). The cost for the excursion (travel, entrance to the Trakai Castle – Vilnius old town tour and lunch break) will be 50 Euros. After the excursion, participants departing from Vilnius airport will be able to stay in Vilnius.

Travel information

Kaunas is the second-largest city in Lithuania, situated in the centre of the country. Here are the most convenient ways of traveling to Kaunas: https://visit.kaunas.lt/en/plan/transport/atvykimas-i-kauna/

Victoria Hotel Kaunas location: Kaunas Bus station – 750 m (10 min on foot or 1 bus stop), Kaunas Railway station – 1,2 km (15 min on foot or 2 bus stops), Kaunas International Airport KUN – 15 km, Vilnius International Airport VNO – 100 km, Palanga International Airport PLQ – 240 km, Riga International Airport RIX - 250 km.

Travel from Kaunas International airport (<u>https://www.kaunas-airport.lt/en/</u>) to Victoria hotel Kaunas: The city bus #29 (its timetable is adjusted to the arrivals schedule) will help you reach the city centre (get off at stop – Griunvaldo). It takes about 40–50 minutes. See information: https://visit.kaunas.lt/en/plan/transport/public-transport/

The price of a single paper ticket bought in the bus from the driver is 1 Euros. But you can also buy a e-tickets, using a mobile app (Ziogas app). Taxi costs about 20 Euros.

Travel from Vilnius International airport (<u>https://www.vilnius-airport.lt/en/</u>) to Kaunas:

To reach Victoria hotel Kaunas you will need to either drive to Kaunas city or take a train or a bus from Vilnius Railway or Bus stations, both are in proximity of each other. To connect from Vilnius Airport to both stations, take the bus routes #1, #2 (direction Airport> Viking st.>Station) or train (Vilnius Airport>Vilnius).

Travel from Palanga International airport (<u>https://www.palanga-airport.lt/en/</u>) to Kaunas: The city bus #31 (its timetable is adjusted to the arrivals schedule) will help you reach the city: 1) get off at first stop – Palanga Bus station, it takes about 12 minutes or get off at last stop – Klaipeda Bus station, it takes about 40 minutes. Parallel sessions:

There will be several parallel sessions on 'Ozone' and 'Moss survey'. Depending on papers offered, the following topics are likely to be presented and discussed:

Ozone (and nitrogen):

- Application and new developments of flux-based methodology and critical levels of ozone for crops, forest trees and (semi-)natural vegetation;
- Updates required to Scientific Background Document B for Chapter 3 of the Modelling and Mapping Manual;
- Monitoring and recording ozone damage on vegetation EU National Emission Ceilings Directive (2016/2284/EU) and smart-phone App;
- Evidence of ozone impacts on crops in developing regions, mapping areas at risk;
- New evidence of nitrogen impacts on vegetation;
- Interactive impacts of ozone and nitrogen on vegetation.

Moss survey:

- Progress toward the report of the 2020/21 moss survey on heavy metals, nitrogen and POPs (at national and regional scale);
- New developments and applications of mosses as biomonitors of heavy metal, nitrogen and POPs pollution;
- Mosses as biomonitors of atmospheric microplastic deposition;
- Preparations for the 2025 moss survey;

Both sessions:

- Outreach activities in Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia (EECCA), Asia and other regions (e.g. Africa, South-America);
- Collaboration with other subsidiary bodies of the Convention, including other ICPs and EMEP Centres/Task Forces.
